Youth United works to inspire their peers across Oxford County. We encourage and mobilize youth ages 12-24 years to see change and create a stronger community by completing a project in partnership with a local organization or school.

Through the support of United Way Oxford, Youth United provides small grants (maximum \$1000) to support local projects and their supporting organization. Projects must align with our desire to support those living in poverty, with mental health and addictions, or supporting kids.

Youth United is currently accepting applications. Once submitted, each applicant will be required to attend an interview with their supporting organization, or school representative. Applicants selected by the Council will receive funding toward the implementation of their initiative and be supported throughout their project.
